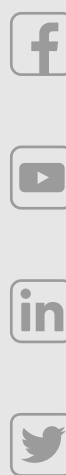




THE DEADLINE IS APPROACHING – SUBMIT YOUR ABSTRACT FOR CIRSE 2020!
