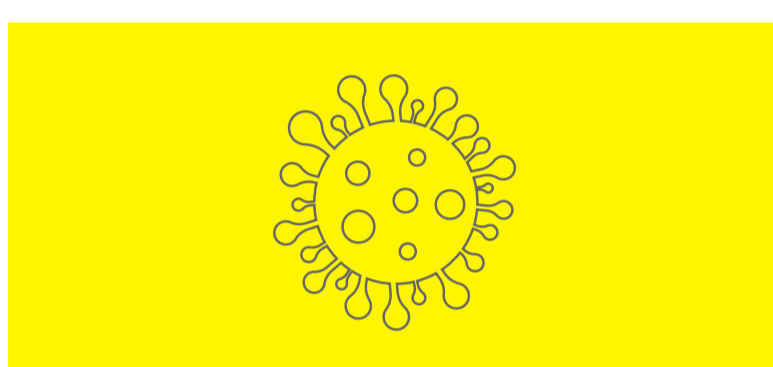
### ECIO Virtual: MSK treatments

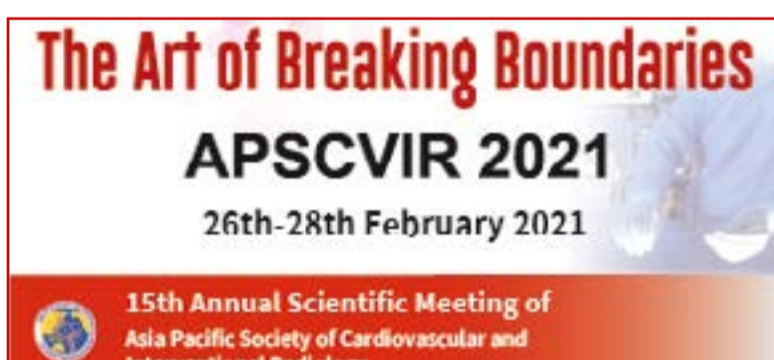
### New SOP on analgesia and sedation
