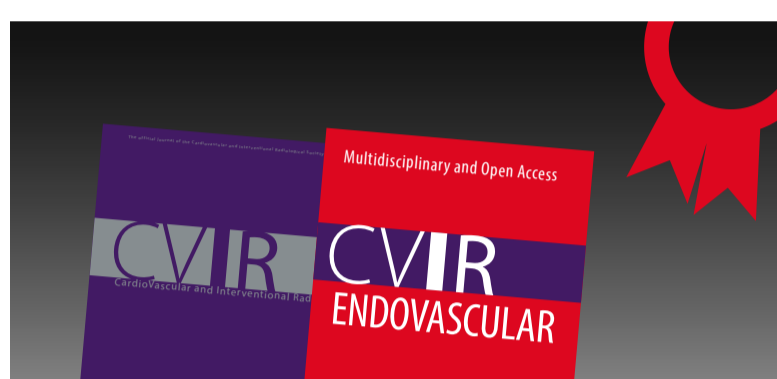
Congratulations to the Editors' Medal winner
