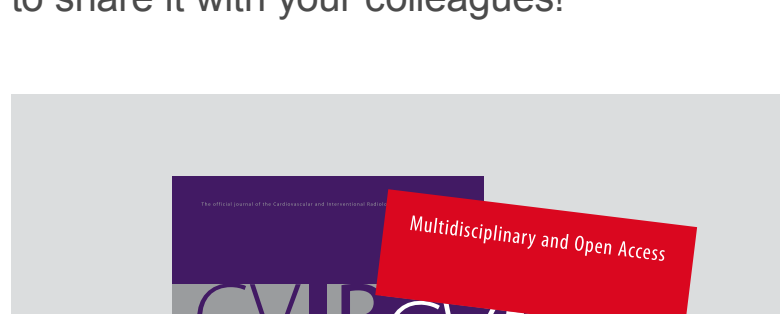
New SOP on bronchial artery embolisation
