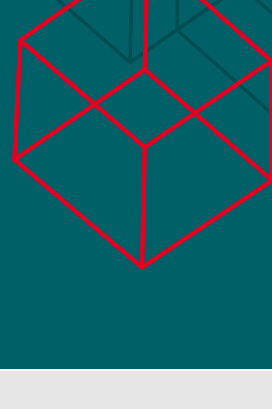

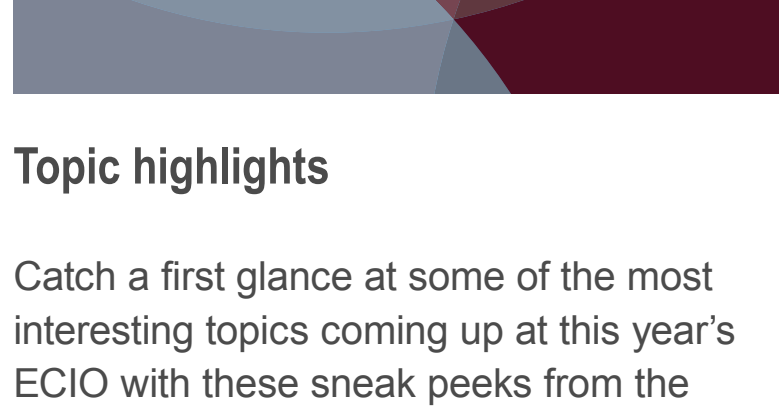

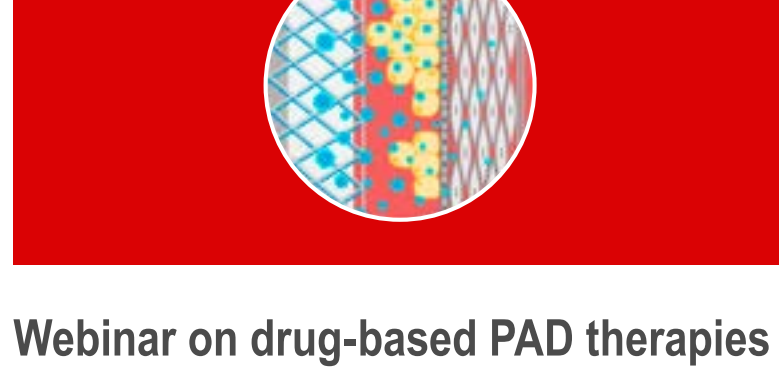
**Topic highlights**

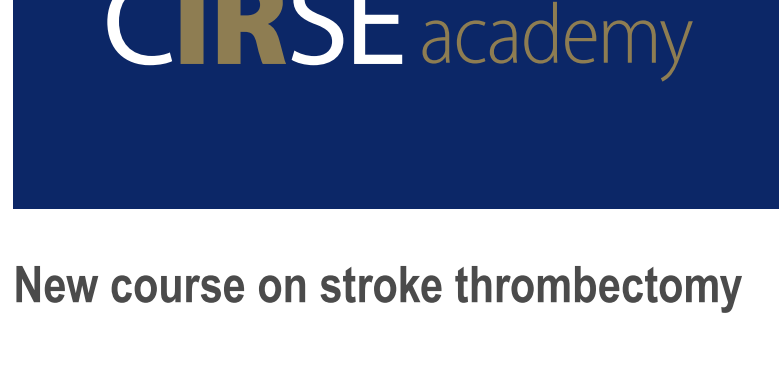
**Webinar on drug-based PAD therapies**

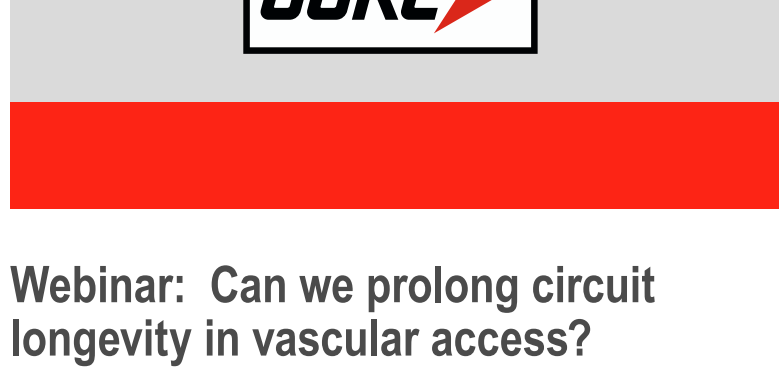
**Webinar on malignant MSK disease**

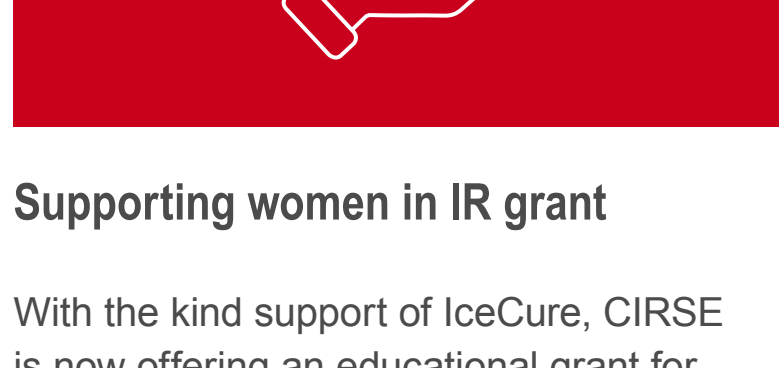
**New course on stroke thrombectomy**

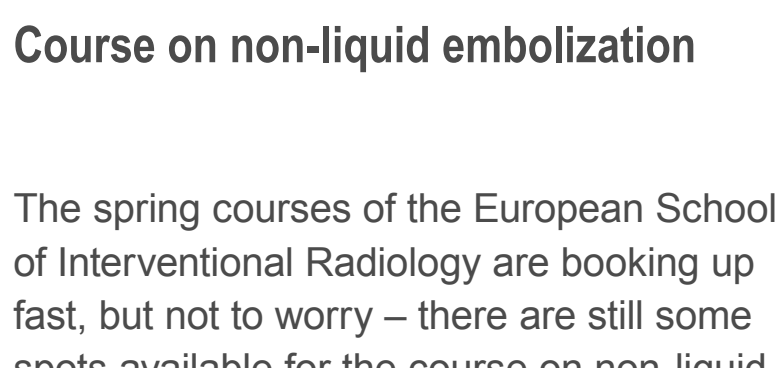
**Supporting women in IR grant**

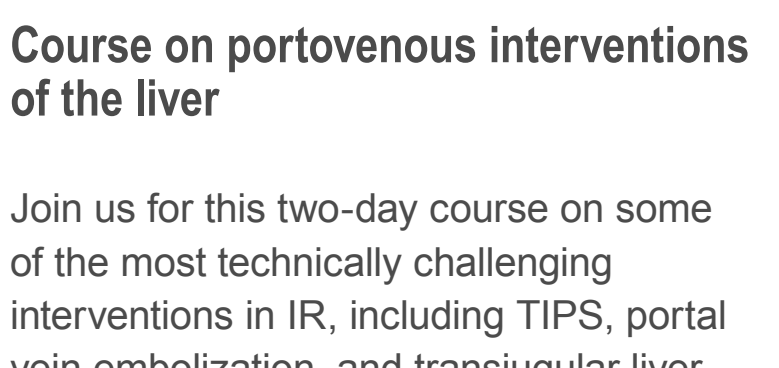
**IR Trainee Support Programme**

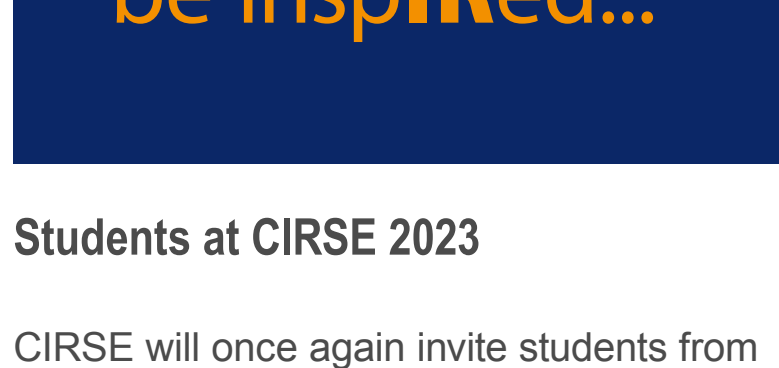
**Course on non-liquid embolization**

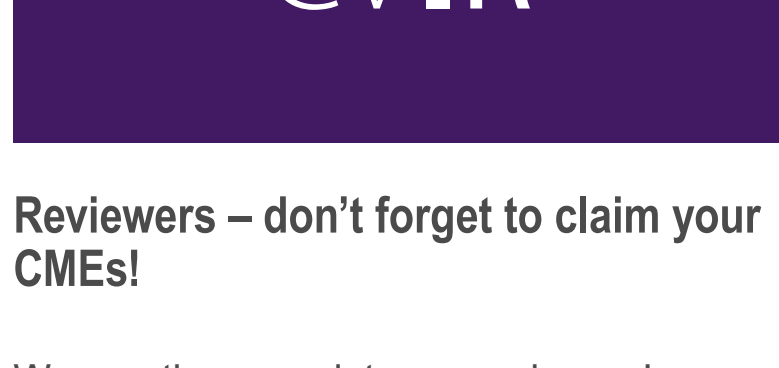
**Students at CIRSE 2023**

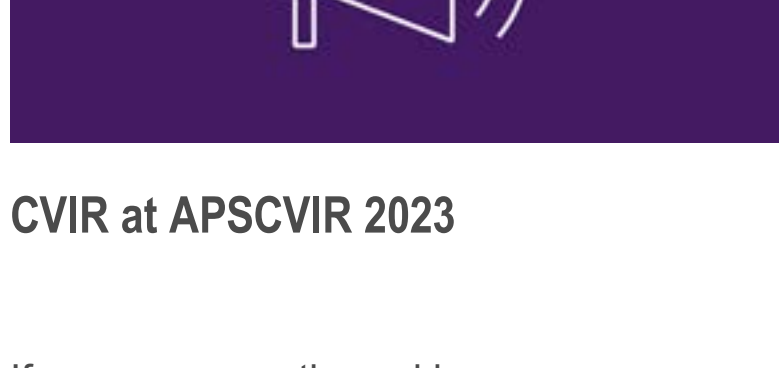
**Author spotlight: Prof. F. Carnevale**
